Indigenous Australians who apply for entry into an undergraduate program at ACU may be given special entry based on potential to succeed in a relevant course. No separate application is required provided the student identifies as an Indigenous student through the online TAC application process. ACU will then invite the student to attend an interview with Faculty & Indigenous Higher Education Unit staff.
