3. JMC Academy Design for Change

Students can follow JMC student projects, as they tackle social solutions while incorporating 2 & 3D visualization, user-friendly devices, UX Design and creative processes. Check out this Instagram account to see real-life industry and higher education projects.

For the past 12 weeks, Digital Design, Animation and Game Development students at JMC Academy have been working on this exciting social integration project and can be followed at the Instagram account **@jmcacademydesign**. The account closely follows their projects and stories as they use design to interpret ways to combat issues of depression and alcoholism.

#JMCDesignforChange aims to show you **the process behind a JMC student project and explores real-world issues through design**. Four teams take on four social problems by developing an answer through creative thinking and design. From raising awareness of underage drinking, attempting to decrease alcohol-related violence, assisting help-centres reach those struggling with depression, and bringing attention to depression in schools, the students are working towards real world change.

"If you ask most people, they will see design as a finished product, whether it be clothes, or interiors or cars, but the most important thing to understand is that design is a process. There is a certain situation, context or problem where we need a solution. So, we embark on a process through a series of steps and rationalisations, we come up with ideas, and that is really the age we are in. We are in an age where ideas are what we are all interested in," says Andrew Barnum, Designer and Lecturer at JMC Academy.

JMC Academy's Head of Digital Design, Diana, describes how "the integration unit allows students from different disciplines to come together and collaborate on projects that make an impact. It is an opportunity for them to explore and experiment with different media and technology, and develop integral skills like leadership, project management and collaboration. The approach that the students take on is rooted in design thinking and displays the power of the creative process to find innovative solutions for real world problems."

Students use design processes such as 'Crazy 8' and 'Rapid Prototyping' to develop and refine their projects, utilising their varied skill sets throughout the project. Digital Design student Anthony described how "all the small things that people are good at come together and give us a very well-oiled machine."

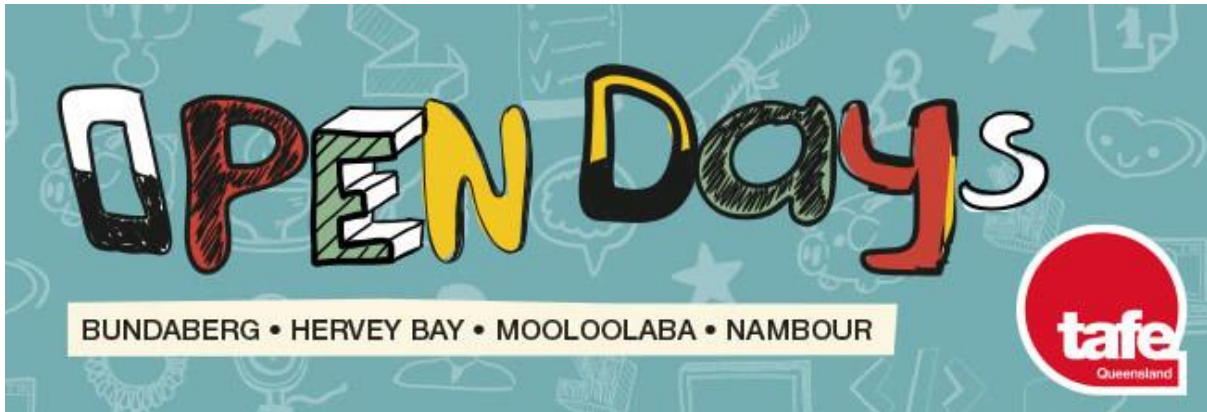

12. Centre for Accident Research & Road Safety Queensland Research Project

Good Shepherd Lutheran College has been invited to participate in a Driver Education & Road Safety Research Project.

Over the past 11 years, a group of Year 11 and 12 students have been attending the Roadcraft Driver Education course at Gympie. Due to this long standing connection, CARRS-Q at QUT have invited our college to contribute to the research directed by a group of PhD researchers.

This week our Year 12 students received the Research Package. Next week the Year 11 students will also receive this package. I strongly encourage all recipients of this important research invitation, to contribute to it.

See below a direct message from Mr David Rothwell, PhD Student (on behalf of the research team)

Participate in an online survey for parents and students

Look out for an information pack going home with grade 11 and 12 students. Students attending Roadcraft as well as students who are not attending Roadcraft can participate.

This project is being conducted with Roadcraft Driver Education and researchers from Queensland University of Technology (QUT) and Griffith University and is investigating the effects of driver education and PC training on novice drivers when compared to novice drivers who do not obtain any extra education or PC training. **Year 11 and 12 students aged 15 years and older** are invited to participate. Participation includes completion of either 2 or 3 online surveys depending upon whether individuals attend Roadcraft driver education or not. If attending, one survey is to be completed prior to going to Roadcraft and the other surveys afterwards. The surveys have Likert scale answers (strongly agree – strongly disagree) and will take approximately 30 minutes. During the survey, participants will also be asked to complete online hazard perception tests, similar to the one used when obtaining a drivers licence, that involves watching a screen and clicking on images. There is also an option to choose to allow the research team access to your licensing and driving records as part of a long-term longitudinal follow up (5 years).

Some example questions are:

- How risky is driving on a wet and slippery road surface?
- Have you ever performed burnouts or donuts on the road?
- How often do you think young drivers you know speed?

Participation is entirely voluntary and any information provided will be kept confidential. It is expected that this project will not directly benefit individual participants. However, it may benefit those in the future who learn to drive and the wider community by increasing knowledge about driver education. To recognise each participants contribution, should they choose to participate, the research team is offering you **a \$15 QBD Bookshop gift voucher** after completion of the online surveys with hazard perception tests. There is much more detail in the information packs provided and these should be read before deciding to participate.
