

GSLC P & F MEETING MINUTES

Meeting – 17th June 2015, Time 3.00pm, Place: Library

OPENING:

FINANCIAL STATEMENT:

- Not discussed in great detail as Renee was not present
- Jason advised \$14,424 was currently in the general banking account with \$94,000 in the long term banking account
- The \$20,000 bill for fair rides is due
- \$8,000 is yet to come in from proceeds of sponsorship for the fair
- \$516 was spent on the recent disco. It is estimated that \$1,000 profit was made. Await confirmation from Renee

FATHERS DAY PLANNING:

- Following a survey conducted of Fathers at school, by Emma, the general consensus is that “Back to the future” is the preferred movie to screen at the Fathers Day movie night. As an added benefit, the rights to this particular title are cheaper than other options
- It was suggested that a sub-committee be formed to make further arrangements for the night – in particular, food to be served on the night as well as ticketing structure. **Wendy, Tara and Tina have all agreed to take on this role and will discuss further**

SECOND HAND UNIFORM SALES:

- It was noted that proceeds were not as high as expected due to miscommunication of information from the school
- Anthony will think of strategies to prevent this occurring in the future. It is noted that SMS notification is preferable in the future
- Un-sold / uniforms unable to be sold, have been donated to an East Timor charity

SHEPHERDS FAIR 8TH AUGUST:

- Raffle tickets are being sent out to families next Monday, before the end of term. Tim Lambert to make a general announcement about this at assembly next week
- All raffle prizes have been donated at no cost to the P & F
- Payment for the requested \$20 per family can be made through Flexi Schools
