Commedia	<p>This term students will study the ancient form of Commedia dell Arte. At the beginning of the term, students will be given guidelines and expectations of Senior Drama. Students will revise the rules of improvisation through warm up games such as Space Jump, Death in a Minute, and Murder in the Marketplace. Students will revise the elements of drama and have a strong knowledge of how to create dramatic meaning.</p> <p>Students will learn about the Dramatic Style of Commedia and the stock characters.
