Original sin; 2. God's first response – The Ten Commandments; 3. God's second response – Jesus; 4. 2	<p>Exploring Religions in India</p> <p><i>Key Idea:</i> Understanding spirituality is linked to culture and context <i>Description:</i> Students study religions in India, making links between religious beliefs and their related symbols, festivals and daily rituals.</p> <p><i>Essential Questions:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ How does my culture influence my spiritual beliefs? ✓ How can I value and respect other religious beliefs? ✓ How does my spirituality influence my lifestyle? 	<p>An Oral Presentation (with props and P/P) highlighting how Indian culture is represented through their religious practices, beliefs and festivals.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students submit the script of the daily life of a follower (of a chosen Indian religion) <p>This script could also highlight an understanding of a related Indian festival.</p>	<p>Issued: Week 6, first lesson</p> <p>Script Due: first lesson Week 9 7B/7D/7E Monday 12th June, 7C Tues, 13th June, 7A Thurs and oral presentations continue into Exam block.</p>
